St John Giant Collection is a month of activity throughout June where we are asking the public and volunteers to collect money in aid of St John.

How can I get involved?

There are 3 main ways you can get involved with the St John Giant Collection:

Join one of our bucket collections



We have bucket collections taking place across England and we're looking for volunteers to help collect at them. Can't see a bucket collection near to you? Why not organise your own?

Place a collection tin



Take one of our collection tins and put them in shops, gyms, leisure centres and libraries in your area.

Collect at home




We'll send you one of our cardboard collection boxes for you to collect at home.

How your money helps

Whichever way you get involved, the money you raise from taking part in the St John Giant Collection will help us to continue to step forward in the moments that matter, save lives and keep communities safe.

Our volunteers provide first aid in their communities, keep people safe at events, and work with the NHS when lives are on the line. They all share the same commitment to offer vital help, on the spot, when it's most desperately needed. Every penny collected makes a difference

£20	could help train new volunteers to continue our lifesaving work.
£40	could provide more ambulance and first aid crews across the country.
